Ranger (Referees)

The Ranger training for initial certification is conducted as an eight (8) hour workshop. This allows ninety (90) minutes at the end of the sessions to take the Ranger Certification Test. The morning will be classroom instruction from 8:30 a.m. until 12:00 noon. In addition to covering the rules, this will include a lesson on child abuse awareness. Lunch will be the responsibility of the attendee. The afternoon session will be from 1:30 p.m. until 3:30 p.m. on a field. Certification testing will be from 4:00 until 5:30.

- Flatbear and pouch
- Certification of Training
- Ranger Certification Testing
